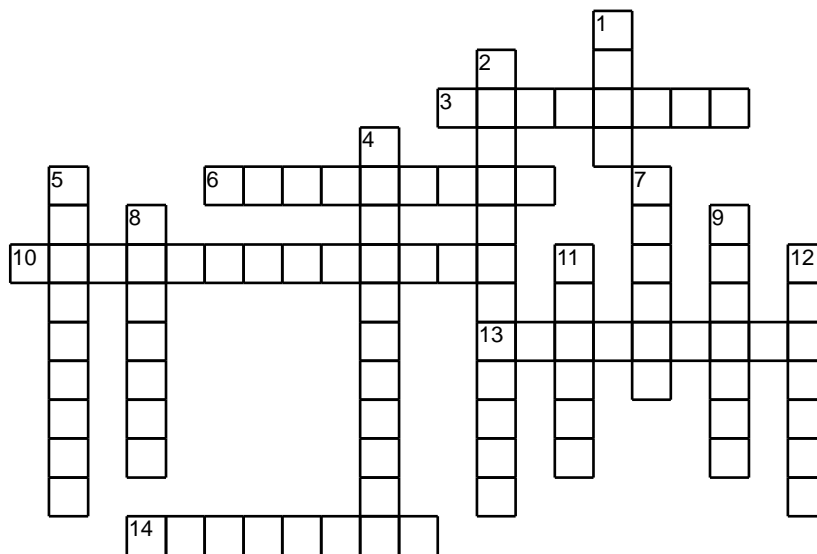


Electricity
