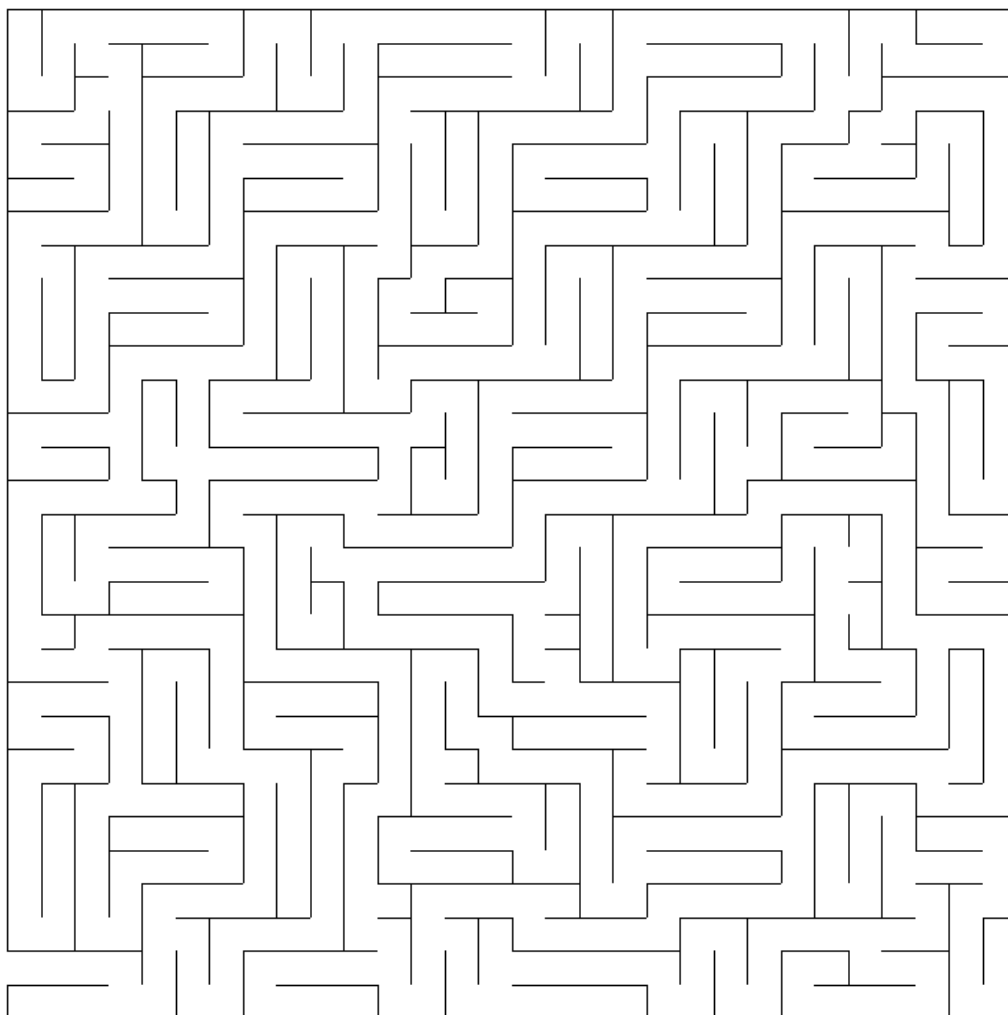


Daedalus' Labyrinth
